Please note that whilst the issued results will rank competitors by score, medals for senior archers shooting a National will only be awarded to archers who have achieved or are working towards achieving 'Archer Tier' as their first ever classification. This is to encourage the novice.

Keeping your records

We will retain your data for a maximum of 5 years following the event. By submitting your personal data you agree to its storage. Bowmen of Minchinhampton will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Notice.

You have the right to
