Rounds	Juniors should enter rounds applicable to their age group. National awards only to 3rd class, unclassified and novice archers. In the event Archery GB Covid guidance increases the area required behind the shooting line, the York round (**) may need to be down graded to a Hereford. Should competitors not wish to shoot, their entry fee will be refunded.
Dress Code	Archery GB Rules of Shooting 307 Dress Regulations
Refreshments	Bacon Rolls (until 2pm), Hot/Cold Drinks, Cake. (subject to Covid rules)
Arrows	As the field is multi use, no 'all carbon' arrows are allowed. All lost arrows to be reported and found by the end of the event
Members Only	Competitors must be Archery GB members. Membership cards to be presented at registration tent
Covid	The tournament will be run strictly in accordance to the latest Archery GB Covid Guidance applicable on the day. Should entries exceed the venue capacity based on the latest spacing guidelines, archer count will be reduced based on 'last in, first out'. The earlier you enter the more likely you will be able to shoot. Should your entry be cancelled due to covid then your entry fee will be refunded. The club accepts no liability for costs the competitor may incur as a result of the cancellation of their entry. The latest guidelines will be circulated to entries 48 hours before the event. Anyone with Covid Symptoms should not attend the competition
PPE & Sanitiser	Please bring your own PPE and sanitiser. Hand sanitiser will be provided in the toilets and food station
Target Type	Straw bosses will be used. On the day please highlight to the field team if you require a harder or softer boss. We will do our best to accommodate

BoM accept not liability for any costs the competitor may have incurred in association with attending the event. Competitors attend the competition at their own risk.
